As in the past, fees may be paid monthly over ten months. The first payment is due before the first day of the first term and thereafter on the 1st DAY OF EVERY MONTH, January to October inclusive.

Interest on outstanding accounts will be charged at 10% per annum. We would also bring to your attention that should the payment of fees fall in arrears, the School Council ruling will apply whereby the learner may be suspended from attending school until such time as the fees are up to date.

These fees cover tuition in all subjects in the school curriculum, including class music, physical education, swimming, computer education and sport.

BOARDING FEE

Per annum R80 800

R20 200 per term payable in full on or before the first day of each term when the child/ward returns from home. A BOARDING ENROLMENT FEE OF ONE TERM'S FEE (R20 200) IS REQUIRED IN ADVANCE TO SECURE YOUR CHILD'S PLACE IN THE BOARDING SCHOOL.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

Please note that A FULL TERM'S NOTICE IN WRITING or one quarter's fees in lieu thereof, is required before withdrawal of a learner from school or boarding.

APPLICATION FEE

A non-refundable application fee of R400 is payable on every application. This fee is to be paid upon the submission of the application forms and all supporting documents.

INSURANCE AND MEDICAL AID

Personal accident insurance is covered by the General Purpose Levy. However, parents are requested to ensure that their children are members of a medical aid scheme and that the school is provided with the medical aid details. The general purpose levy covers your child if they are injured on the way to school or home, school trips, sporting events or injuries that occur on school property. It covers all casualty costs, x-rays, physiotherapy, and follow up appointments. Should your child/ward require hospitalization your medical aid will be utilized, if you do not have medical aid an affidavit is required and there will be a R50 000 in hospital limit.

Please take note that the school will not be held liable for theft/loss of learners' possessions whilst on the school property. Parents are requested to ensure that all their children's possessions are insured under their own personal insurance policies.

GENERAL PURPOSE LEVY

This annual levy covers, personal accident insurance, expenses such as basic text books, computer and library usage, basic stationery, basic printing and photocopying, school photos, school magazine, school trips and camps, limited plays and shows, transport to and from local league sporting events, local cultural events and most compulsory school outings.

NB: GENERAL PURPOSE LEVY IS DUE AT THE BEGINNING OF THE ACADEMIC YEAR.

ENROLMENT FEE

A non-refundable enrolment fee of R3 250 is to be paid immediately once the learner has been accepted in order to secure his/her position.

Present St Nicholas Grade 7 learners are required to pay a refundable enrolment fee of R2 000 in order to secure their position in Grade 8, this amount will be refunded in January. Please take note that this fee will not be refunded, should the learner not return for Grade 8.
